

Catch a Fish Activity Guide

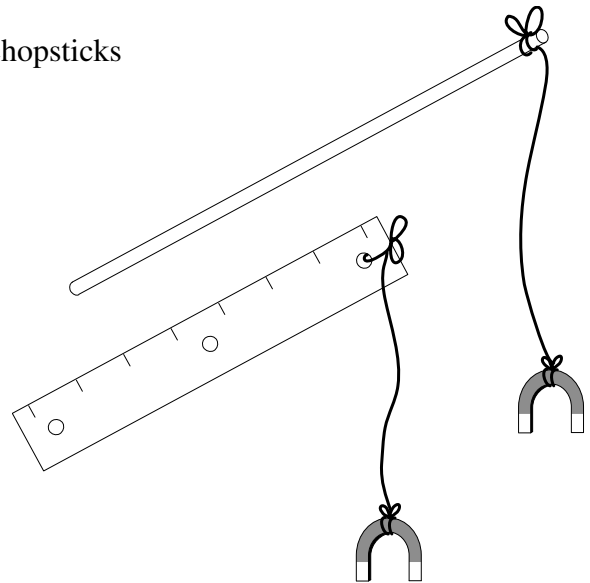
Joy Carpets invites you to take your children on a magnetic fishing expedition! Follow these simple instructions to create an interactive magnetic fishing game.

What you will need:

- Rulers with holes, unsharpened pencils, or chopsticks
- String or yarn (about 36" for each "pole")
- Small magnets
- Computer and printer
- Safety scissors
- Metal paper clips

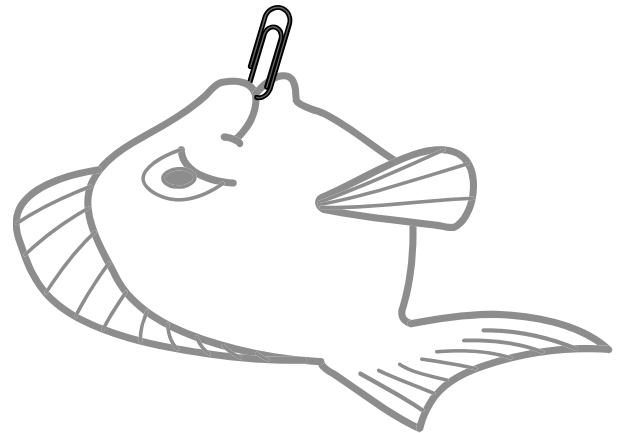
Making the fishing pole:

Tie string or yarn to the "fishing pole."
Use a rubber band or tape to secure the string, or use a ruler with a hole in the end.
Tie the magnet to the other end of the string.



Making the Fish:

Print out the pattern provided in these instructions. The children can decorate the fish and write their names on them. Cut out the fish shapes and attach the metal paperclip to the mouth area. Be sure to poke the clip through the paper as shown.



Softer Options:

You can use tightly rolled newspaper, instead of a stick or ruler. Substitute hook and loop tape instead of the magnet and metal paper clips
